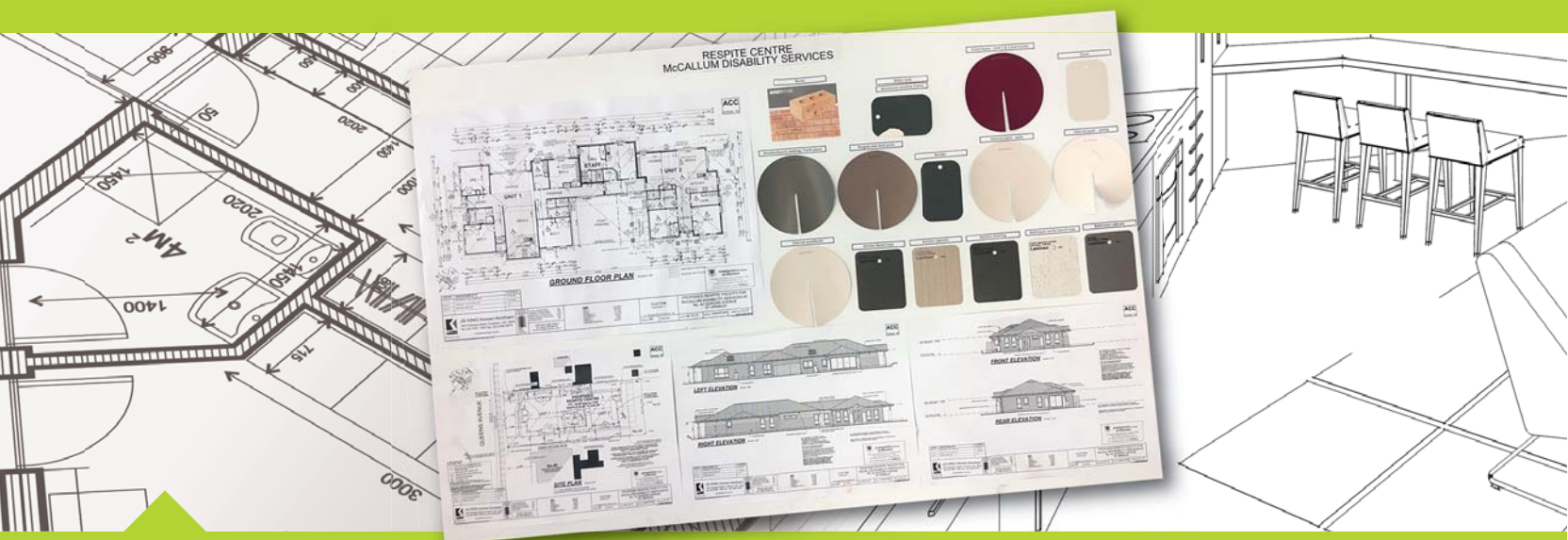
McCallum has a diverse range of accommodation options including 1, 2, 3 bedroom units and shared homes in Ballarat and surrounding areas.

When Ella became an adult she wanted to move out of home; a very normal desire for any young adult! We then proceeded to get the wheels in motion to try and find her suitable accommodation with the level of 24 hour care that she needs.

We were understandably nervous, apprehensive and worried about how Ella would make the transition from being with us (and having never attended overnight respite) to a complete change. We were also excited for her but as parents of a very precious, very complicated, and often very sick child we were way more worried than she was.

From the moment Ella walked in her unit became her home. Her transition was seamless thanks to the caring and well-trained staff and house manager. She loves her home and hasn't once asked to come back home to us!

The meeting of Ella's medical needs, her everyday support needs and her development into a more mature and responsible young adult have exceeded our expectations.

Don't get me wrong, she can give the staff a run for their money and does; but we feel completely confident that her needs, development, independence and happiness (the backbone of McCallum's vision) are met and they certainly follow through on that promise to us.
