So, you've finished school. Now what do you do?

Like many young adults leaving secondary school, you may be overwhelmed by what you want to do in the future. If you're not sure about what you'd like to do or want to sample some of the options available to you, then the School Leavers Employment Support (SLES) might be what you're looking for.

SLES offers individualised mentoring and support for young people up to the age of 25 to plan your pathway into Employment.

How do I get SLES in my NDIS Plan?

If you don't have SLES in your NDIS
Plan you will need to contact your
Local Area Coordinator (LAC) to
request that SLES funding be included
in your NDIS Plan. In order for SLES
to be in your NDIS Plan you will need
to request a "Plan Review"





What important skills and supports are part of the SLES program?

SLES supports will be tailored to mee your individual employment goals, which may include but not limited to:

- Travel training
- Time managemen
- Money handling
- Further study and individualised training
- Ongoing access to training in Industry accredited courses such as:
- Food Safety Handling Certificate
- Espresso Coffee Training
- Cover letter and resume writing
- Job application and interview skills
- Retail customer service training
- Potential to explore volunteer work
- Work placements in area of specific interest
- Connecting participants with other specialised support services
- Individualised case management by one of McCallum's SLES mentors
- Opportunities to explore different Industries by attending site tours
- Attending and engaging in regular 1:1 mentoring sessions
- On the job support once employment has been secured
