Choose what you'd like to do

McCallum's short term accommodation is based on participants having a fun and enjoyable experience. To ensure the 'fun criteria' is met, McCallum staff and participants meet to plan the activities they'd like to undertake during their stay.



This includes:

- Discussing the choice of the supports you would like during your stay
- Activity and excursion planning
- Meal planning and preparation
- Transportation planning

McCallum can also help you with any skill development and daily living tasks you wish to pursue.
